

**CLEAR CREEK COUNTY
RENEWAL OF AN ISDS PERMIT APPLICATION**

A Renewal ISDS Permit is required when an ISDS system has not been initiated or completed within two (2) years from the date of issuance of a new Permit.

Construction, repair, alteration or excavation of an ISDS system cannot continue after the initial ISDS Permit has expired, unless a Renewal ISDS Permit is issued by the Environmental Health Department.

A RENEWAL ISDS PERMIT MUST BE OBTAINED PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE INITIAL ISDS PERMIT. FAILURE TO OBTAIN THE RENEWAL PERMIT PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE INITIAL ISDS PERMIT WILL REQUIRE A NEW INITIAL ISDS APPLICATION.
